



NOTHING NEEDS TO BE EXACT
 USE WHATEVER YOU HAVE ON HAND
 Height of Wickets should vary and be
 between 3" and 9" in height depending
 on height of smallest dog.

Use 1/2", 3/4" and/or 1" diameter pipe.



Drill holes to fit snug and
 leave about 3/8" at bottom.

or



Drill holes a little oversized
 and place a small piece of
 plywood under hole.

2x4x8'-0" or so for each Rail.

5 or 6 Wickets spaced a little unevenly.
 Make from 3 pieces of pipe and 2 elbows.

Rigid plastic pipe is easiest but steel pipe
 or electrical conduit will do. One can
 even use solid steel bent rods.

Tie Rails together at each end with 1x
 wood piece under Rails. Use 3/8" carriage
 bolts through Rails with nut and washer
 on bottom side.

Place Walk across two oil drums, wood
 blocks, ladders or whatever you have.

Start the training with Walk just above
 ground, and gradually increase the height
 as the dog becomes more comfortable.
